SUBJECT: Request for Change of Shoulder Sleeve Insignia for Retired Soldiers

1. Reference: Army Regulation (AR) 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, 25 May 2017
2. I approve your request to change the Retired Shoulder Sleeve Insignia (SSI) worn on the new Army Green Service Uniform. This will align the retired SSI with the retired service ID badge currently worn on the Army Blue Service and Dress Uniform by retired Soldiers to include the Army retired lapel button issued to each Soldier at retirement.
